Christmas fire safety

Don't let a house fire spoil your festive celebrations! This time of year creates more fire hazards than usual. Make sure you and your family stay safe. Follow these tips from Brian, our fire safety officer:

Candles

- Snuff out candles and tealights at night
- Never leave children or pets alone in a room with a lit candle
- Do not place tealights on a plastic surface
- Place candles away from real Christmas trees

Kitchen

- Don't leave pans unattended
- Take care when wearing loose clothing near flames
- Keep tea towels away from the hob
- Never leave children or pets alone in the kitchen



Christmas lights and gadgets

- Check cables and power sockets for damage
- Don't overload sockets keep to one plug per socket
- Always use the correct charger! Never use a mobile phone charger to charge your vaping device



Portable heaters

- Keep heaters clear from curtains and furniture
- Never use heaters for drying clothes
- Switch off when not needed
- Do not leave heater unattended

And finally...

- Switch off and unplug electrical appliances that are not in use
- Shut all internal doors at night to stop a fire from spreading
- Test your fire alarm regularly! #TestItTuesday

First tenants at Canary Quay

Brandon Cheesman (pictured) was one of the first tenants to set up home at our new Canary Quay development in Norwich in October.

Previously Brandon (20) was living in shared accommodation at the YMCA. He grew up in Norwich and has been working in tree surgery with his grandad. He is hoping to become a tree surgeon himself. His one-bedroom 5th-floor apartment at Canary Quay is his first home:

"This new flat has got everything. When my mum saw it, she was so excited she joked that she wanted to move out of her own house and live here!"

Another new tenant is retired railwayman Andrew Parfitt, who used to work at the nearby rail depot:

"When I first saw the flat I was amazed – it's so nice. My dad was a builder, so I can appreciate the quality of the finish. It's done to a great standard."

Altogether 60 one- and twobedroom apartments at Canary Quay will be for social rent. This is the first phase in our ambitious development that will eventually create 323 new homes on the site.
