SLIP, TRIP AND FALL

WHAT HAPPENED?

Several accidents and near misses have been reported involving slip, trip and fall hazards. These have included:

Raised door threshold – newly installed Trailing hose

Uneven ground surface
Unsafe working practice at height – within stairwell

visually impaired etc); tenants AND visitors in the area including deliveries, contractors, emergency services.

. Do not assume that others will notice warning signage or the hazard.

 Keep vigilant, the work environment around you can change – what was a 'quiet' area can suddenly get busy. You may need to stop and change control measures to suit

If you are in doubt or you are concerned that suitable controls are not in place, then stop what you are doing and contact the Health and Safety Team for advice.
